I believe that 2024 is the start of the 3rd Generation of Darts for Dreams. Why do you ask? Here's why? The first few years, we moved around almost every year. The location changed; the date even fluctuated from our now standard end of April date. We kept doing better than the year before, but each year sort of stood alone. The 2nd Generation, we moved over to Cook AA. We started to raise more money. We started to raffle off a TV. We built on the good things and changed the bad things. We had a space for storage which let us start earlier, get bigger items, and get organized sooner. The totals jumped considerably – with our last year before Cook AA raising \$21,035, and our last year at Cook AA raising \$91,235! During those years, we built continuity and a structure to succeed. Now, here we are, the first year at the Bordentown Elks, a new beginning of sorts. We've had to adjust, without doubt. We don't have storage here and we're going to finish setting up the morning of the event. We have the power and potential of over a thousand members to stop in and see what it's all about. We're hoping to cross the \$100,000 mark this year and set our eyes on one million dollars raised in just a few more years.

Can anyone who's been involved since 2006 say they thought this would become what it has? Even I can't. I'm still amazed at the support we get from the communities that participate and the successes we've had. In some ways, each year gets easier, but the goal gets bigger. So, let's do what we've done each year and just crush it!

Since 2006 - Over \$725,000 and nearly 70 wishes granted!!!
