We know that Hugo's shopping spree will be a source of joyful memories and we can't wait to hear all about what he treated himself to when he returns.


Jaggar is a sixteen-year-old boy who loves to listen to Lady Gaga and the Black Eyed Peas. He is also a huge New York Yankees fan, loves the movie Role Models, and loves to watch Saturday Night Live. When Make-A-Wish volunteers visited with Jaggar and his family, they asked him that same magical question, where he wished to go on a Mediterranean Cruise with his family. While on the cruise, Jaggar and his family will be visiting a few European countries along the Mediterranean Sea. The simple question, "If you had one wish, what would it be?" has been translated into wishes for over 6,300 children throughout New Jersey in the last 27 years. Last year, we granted 471 unique, special and magical wishes such as the wish of a little boy to visit the extended family he's never met in Poland, or the wish of a teenage girl to go on a shopping spree as she prepared to return to school following a prolonged absence. One young lady wished to meet her favorite singer and her wish came true when he not only sat down to speak with her, but also asked her to join him on stage for an encore. Many more magical wishes to Disney World were also granted and made countless little girls and boys feel like princesses and superheroes- feelings their illnesses have temporarily taken away.

Research has shown us that roughly 800 children are diagnosed with a life-threatening medical condition annually in the state of New Jersey. Each year, we strive to identify an ever-increasing number of these children whose hospital visits, treatments and overall outlook on their illness has the potential to be more positive after that one memorable wish has been granted.

In our 27-year history, no wish-eligible child has ever been turned down because of a lack of funding and that's because we have caring donors like you, and those who supported the 5th Annual "Darts for Dreams" Dart-a-thon, who have helped make these wishes come true. Once again, thank you for helping us restore hope, strength and joy to Hugo's and Jaggar's lives, and the lives of their families, and for *sharing the power of a wish*®!
