

Thank you for registering with the GTDL to participate in the 2017 NJ State Cricket Championships.

Please read this entire message. Your payment confirms your participation in the event and an agreement to all of the rules stipulated.

Failure to abide by the rules will result in a removal from the event, forfeiture of funds and disqualification from future events.

1. Only open to NJ residents (and NJ stationed military personnel).
2. Pre-registration and payment must be completed before Tuesday, February 21, 2017.
 - a. NO walk-ins allowed on day of event.
3. The draw will be completed and posted by Friday, February 24, 2017.
4. Refunds after the draw is published will not be provided.
5. Check in time will start at Noon on the day of the event. Check in time will end at 12:45 PM on the day of the event. ALL players must check in at the event on time. **Plan your trip and be on time!**
6. A players meeting will be held at 12:50 PM on the day of the event to review rules, logistics and answer any questions. Failure to check in and attend the players meeting may result in a forfeited entry with no refunds. **Plan your trip and be on time!**
7. A dress code will be in effect. Slacks/khakis and a collared shirt a must. Footwear is your choice. No jeans, sweats, shorts, t-shirts or hats. Women, skirts/dresses, dress shirts allowed. We realize this is different than most other events and appreciate your compliance. If you even think that it will be questioned, consider it unacceptable. Players arriving without proper dress code will have the time until the players meeting to be in compliance or forfeit their entry without refund. **Come Prepared!**
8. Payment must be made either

9. A list of paid entries will be kept and shared on a Facebook event page (<https://www.facebook.com/events/573761242818464/>) hosted by the GTDL (<http://www.facebook.com/GreaterTrentonDartLeague>) . It will updated periodically leading up to the event.
10. Event payback will be 100%

Event details:

1. Cricket is the game.
2. The event will start with a round robin format, with the number of groups and players/group determined when registration closes. All players will play everyone in their group.
3. After the round robin portion, the top 8 players (winners from groups + additional players based on wins) will determine the top 8 for the elimination rounds.
4. Matches in a round robin format will be less than 5 legs, but will be play all legs (i.e. all 3 instead of best of 5)
5. Once called, players will have 9 warm up darts on the board.
6. PDC cork rule to start. Alternate legs for the duration of the match (including last leg). The player listed on top of the match on the bracket **will** shoot bull first.
7. Match results should be brought back to the event control table promptly.
8. First round match scorers will be assigned by the event director. (Based on byes or last name in the bracket)
9. Players losing their matches will be required to chalk an upcoming match. Failure to oblige will result in disqualification from the next NJ State Dart Championship (501 or Cricket). The event director may assign different boards based on need.
10. All decisions by the Event Director and staff will be final.

Men's/Women's event --Separate men's and women's events will occur.**1. Men's event**

- a. Registration Noon, Players Meeting 12:50, Darts at 1:00 PM.
- b. Round robin then a bracket format. Groups and match format tbd.
- c. Cork – PDC cork rule. Top name in bracket shoots first. Round robin – coin toss to shoot first.
- d. Alternate start throughout the match, including last leg.

2. Women's event

- a. Registration at 1:00 PM, Players Meeting 1:50 PM, Darts at 2:00 PM.
- b. Round robin then a bracket format. Groups and match format tbd.
- c. Cork – PDC cork rule. Top name in bracket shoots first. Round robin – coin toss to shoot first.
- d. Alternate start throughout the match, including last leg.
- e. The event will be canceled if less than four women register/pay in time. Refunds will be sent.

Host Location Details:

2. Located within 10 minutes of I-295 and exits 62 and 63, as well as the NJ Turnpike exist 7A (I-195).
3. Limited kitchen (Burgers/Cheesesteaks/Chicken/Fried Goodies).
4. Bar on site. Buckets available.
5. Location will be split into two rooms (Lounge and Pool Room)
 - a. The Lounge will have four game boards (1 to 4). Two additional stands will be available as warm up boards.
 - b. The Pool Room will have four game boards (5 to 8) in a separate room across the bowling front desk.
6. Pending the number of attendees, we may require use of both rooms or all matches may be in one room. Timing and event progression will determine that.
7. Smoking is not allowed in the bowling alley. The main entrance and side entrance (next to the kitchen) have outside access.
8. The lounge doors to outside will be closed for the day.
