- There's a \$10 donation at the door. We'll give out gift bags with whatever we can collect until we run out and you'll get all kinds of free stuff!
- At some point during the day, we should have the Make-A-Wish team and hopefully a Wish Family talk about their experience and how your participation and support matters.
- There is no bracket or set matches. You just play darts! It's just \$5 to shoot 51 darts for a high score and \$20 for a team of 4 entries. You play as often or as little as you want.
- Hourly prizes are given out to the highest Male/Female and GTDL scores. There's also a team prize for the highest 4-person score.
- Throughout the day, we'll also give out cash prizes to random scores.
- There's going to be raffles, a 50/50 plus a great silent auction.
- Enjoy the day! If you can't have fun when you play darts and raise money for kids with critical illnesses, this isn't the event for you.
